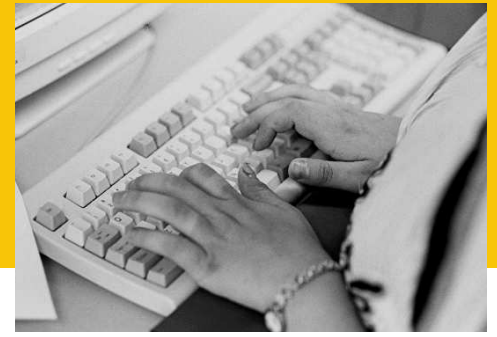


Health Information Technology Consulting Services
