Technical Assistance to Meet Community Needs

Community Technical Assistance – Providing information and technical assistance in the areas of epidemiology, toxicology, environmental and occupational medicine, education and training, and policy development.

Researching the Connections between Health and the Environment

Health Studies – Providing assistance to community-led investigations and conducting research on connections between health and exposures in community and occupational settings.

Environmental Health Profiles – Assisting residents, public officials, and health providers in gathering and evaluating community-specific information on health status and potential exposure sources.

Supporting Broad-Based Community Initiatives to Improve Environmental Health

Capacity Building – Working to build the capacity of individuals and community-based organizations to identify, evaluate, and take action to resolve environmental health issues.

Coalition Building – Assisting in the formation and operation of broad-based coalitions to plan and implement community-wide change: Identifying stakeholders, defining operating processes, conducting meetings and planning sessions, identifying strategies, managing conflict, and building consensus.

Policy Development – Consulting on all areas of environmental health, including prevention of occupational disease, reduction of environmental exposure, and public participation in environmental programs.

Education and Outreach to Build Effective Leadership

Education and Training – Developing programs and materials on environmental health, pollution prevention, public involvement, and community leadership.

Model Initiatives – Developing model programs to engage and support multicultural populations working to resolve issues of environmental justice.
