Since the beginning of the epidemic, JSI has been committed to the fight against HIV and is dedicated to helping achieve the goals of the National HIV/AIDS Strategy (NHAS)

at both the federal and local levels. Through our work with HHS, HRSA, CDC, and other federal partners, JSI supports the delivery, coordination, evaluation, and improvement of HIV prevention, health care, and support services across the US. JSI, in collaboration with state and local health departments and community-based organizations, helps ensure that services address the needs of people at risk for or living with HIV, while reducing or eliminating disparities in access to care and health outcomes.

Reducing New HIV Infections

Capacity-Building Assistance – Enhancing organizational capacity to implement and evaluate evidence-based interventions to prevent HIV among high-risk populations.

Prevention Planning – Guiding community planning groups in the development of comprehensive HIV prevention plans through training and technical assistance.

Prevention Evaluation – Helping organizations gather and use data to evaluate services and meet CDC's National HIV Prevention Program Monitoring & Evaluation requirements.

Increasing Access to Care and Improving Health Outcomes for People Living with HIV

Comprehensive Planning – Conducting needs assessments, identifying people living with HIV (PLWH) who are not in care, assessing disparities, and developing comprehensive HIV plans.

Quality Management – Assessing quality management activities and implementing innovative strategies and plans to ensure high-quality clinical services.

Program Evaluation – Conducting studies and building capacity to evaluate HIV services.

Data Management – Building skills and systems to collect, manage, use, and report HIV data.

Training and Technical Assistance – Providing specialized management and programmatic assistance to develop, implement, and evaluate HIV care and support services.

Achieving a More Coordinated Response to the Epidemic

PLWH Participation – Ensuring that PLWH and affected communities are active participants in the planning and delivery of HIV prevention, care, and support services.

New Media Technology – Developing and implementing innovative Web-based and multi-media strategies to facilitate HIV outreach, education, training, and technical assistance.

Research – Implementing surveys, focus groups, and other research techniques to gather data from PLWH and those at risk to help achieve or measure progress toward NHAS goals.

Policy Studies – Assessing the impact of legislation and policy on the delivery of HIV prevention and care services and the quality of life for PLWH and those at risk.
